LIGHT AND VESSELS

This painting is inspired by a section of the monumental Kabbalisitic work *Talmud Eser Sefirot*, written by the Holy Spiritual Master Rav Yehudah Leib HaLevi Ashlag z"l.

The Kabbalah discusses 10 aspects of our inner consciousness called *Sefirot*. The 10 *Sefirot* describe the interface between our present experience of separation, and our coming to the realization of oneness.

In advanced learning of Kabbalah it is explained that each of the 10 *Sefirot* contain all 10 of the *Sefirot*, in various combinations of Direct Light and Returning Light. Direct Light is when we experience G-D's love. Returning Light is when we are trying to return the love to G-D.

We learn in the Kabbalah that Direct Light is experienced through Returning Light.

In this painting the 10 *Sefirot* are represented by 9 squares and 1 rectangle. Each of the *Sefirot* is painted in a color that is associated with that particular *Sefira*.

Each of the *Sefirot* contains 10 triangles representing the 10 *Sefirot* contained within itself. The colors of the triangles are also the same colors associated with each particular *Sefira*. The triangles that represent Direct Light point downwards. The triangles that represent Returning Light point upwards.

The 10 Sefirot and one of many ways of translating their meaning and associated state of consciousness is:

Keter Purpose of Creation / Infinite Goodness

Chochma Experience of Oneness

Bina State of Unconditional Love

Chesed Loving Kindness

Gevurah Humility
Tiferet Harmony
Netzach Eternity
Hod Thankfulness

Yesod Unity

Malchut Central Point in the Heart

The top middle square of the painting represents the 1st *Sefira* of *KETER*. The top right square of the painting represents *CHOCHMA*. The top left square represents *BINA*. The middle right square represents *CHESED*. The middle left square represents *GEVURAH*. The middle center square represents *TIFERET*. The lower right square represents *NETZACH*. The lower left square represents *HOD*. The lower middle square represents *YESOD*. The rectangle at the bottom of the painting represents *MALCHUT*.

KETER contains 9 Direct Lights and 1 Returning Light. *CHOCHMA* contains 8 Direct Lights and 2 Returning Lights. *BINA* contains 7 Direct Lights and 3 Returning Lights, and so on until *MALCHUT* which contains 10 Returning Lights.

KETER of the *KETER*, the highest of all the *Sefirot*, is not depicted. *KETER* is associated with the infinite and eternal unconditional love of the Divine that is hidden within the root of our every moment.
